

- 2. (1) 34" Approach Foot Bar (2) T-Slot Nuts + (2) 3/4" Bolts + (2) Washers 2.1 Intermediate Pulley
- **3. (2) Dry Box** + (8) 5/8" Bolts + (8) T-Slot Nuts + (8) 1-1/4" Washers (large)
- 4. (2) Folding Seat + (12) Bolts (included on seats)

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

NOTE: A tube of Thread Lock has been included for assembly purposes. Thread Lock can be applied to any bolt or screw to prevent unwanted loosening over time.

1. Inflate Raft

- a. Ensure all valves are in the closed position.
- Inflate the Approach 138 Raft using the provided Super 2 HP
 Pump or an electric pump.
 - Note: For optimal results, partially inflate all chambers before bringing any one chamber up to pressure (2 PSI).

2. Position Slot Rails

 a. Place (2) Slot Rails centered on top of the straight tube section on each side of the raft.

3. Attach 43" Approach Foot Bar

- Slide a T-Slot Nut into each of the Slot Rails approximately 17-19" from the front.
- b. Place Foot Bar on top of the Slot Rails with the fitting thru holes and T-Slot Nuts aligning, and the bent part of the bar dipping toward the raft floor.
 - The rectangular boss on the Slot Pro fittings should fit into the slot on the Slot Rails.
- c. Attach **Foot Bar** to the **Slot Rails** with (2) 3/4" Bolts and (2) Washers and tighten with 1/2" socket wrench.
 - i. COMPLETELY tighten bolts.
 - Note: The Foot Bar should be located the same distance from the front of each Slot Rail.

4. Attach Folding Seats

- Attach (2) Folding Seats to the top of (2) Dry Boxes with bolts (taped to the underside of the seat), finger-tighten to align all four holes and bolts.
 - The front of the angler's seat should face the side of the dry box that opens (latch side).
 - ii. The front of the rower's seat should face the side of the dry box that does **not** open (hinge side).
 - Apply Aquaseal to (4) holes in the bottom of the seat before inserting bolts.
 - iv. COMPLETELY tighten bolts with 3/8" socket wrench.

5. Attach Bow Rod Tube Brackets

- a. Slide (1) **T-Slot Nut** into each **Slot Rail** approximately 15-17" from the front
- b. Place (1) Bow Rod Tube Bracket at the front of each Slot Rail.
- c. Align **T-Slot Nuts** in each **Slot Rail** with the **Rod Tube Bracket** thru holes
- d. Attach **Rod Tube Brackets** to the **Slot Rails** with (2) 3/4" Bolts and (2) Washers.

DO NOT completely tighten.

6. Attach Angler's Dry Box

- a. Slide (2) **T-Slot Nuts** into each **Slot Rail** from the front (4 total, 2 in each side).
- b. Place (1) Dry Box on top of each Slot Rail towards the front

(2 total)

- c. Align T-Slot Nuts in each Slot Rail with the Dry Box thru holes.
- d. Attach **Dry Box** to the **Slot Rails** with (4) 5/8" Bolts and (4) Washers (large) using a ½" socket wrench.
- e. Repeat steps b. through d. with second Dry Box.

DO NOT completely tighten.

7. Attach Oar Mount w/ SpinLock

- a. Slide (2) **T-Slot Nuts** into the **Slot Rail** Right, from the back.
- Place Oar Mount w/ SpinLock just forward of center of the Slot Rail Right.
- Align T-Slot Nuts in the Slot Rail Right with the Oar Mount w/ SpinLock thru holes.
- d. Attach Oar Mount to the Slot Rail Right with (2) 5/8" Bolts and (2) Washers.

DO NOT completely tighten.

8. Attach Oar Mount

- a. Slide (2) T-Slot Nuts into the Slot Rail Left, from the back.
- b. Place Oar Mount just forward of center of the Slot Rail Left, straight across from the Oar Mount w/ SpinLock.
- Align T-Slot Nuts in the Slot Rail Left with the Oar Mount thru
 holes.
- d. Attach Oar Mount to the Slot Rail Left with (2) 5/8" Bolts and (2) Washers.

DO NOT completely tighten.

9. Attach Rower's Dry Box

- a. Slide (2) T-Slot Nuts into each Slot Rail from the back (4 total, 2 in each side)
- Place Dry Box on top of the Slot Rails 2-1/2" from the back of the rails.
- c. Align T-Slot Nuts in each Slot Rail with the Dry Box thru holes.
- d. Attach **Dry Box** to the **Slot Rails** with (4) 5/8" Bolts and (4) Washers (large) using a ½" socket wrench.

DO NOT completely tighten.

10. Attach Stern Rod Tube Combo Brackets

- a. Slide (2) T-Slot Nuts into each Slot Rail from the back.
- Position Stern Rod Tube Combo Brackets 17" forward from the back of the rails.
- c. Align T-Slot Nuts in each Slot Rail with the Stern Rod Tube Combo Bracket thru holes.
- d. Attach Stern Rod Tube Combo Brackets to the Slot Rails with (4) 3/4" Bolts and (4) Washers.

DO NOT completely tighten.

11. Attach Straight Rod Tubes

- a. Place Straight Rod Tubes on top of each Slot Rail. There are 5 holes in each rod tube. The group of 3 holes goes towards the stern. There are two countersunk holes with a 1/4" drain hole between.
- Align Straight Rod Tube countersunk holes with the threaded holes in the Rod Tube Brackets.
- c. Attach the Straight Rod Tubes to the Rod Tube Brackets with (6)

1/2" screws and a #3 Phillips screwdriver.

i. **COMPLETELY** tighten screws.

12. Tighten all bolts on Slot Rail components

- Ensure Dry Boxes, Seats, Oar Mounts and Approach Foot Bar are in their desired positions.
- Firmly secure all components attached to the Slot Rails by completely tightening all assembly bolts.

13. Attach Bow Rod Tubes

- a. Slip (1) Frame Coupler over the front of each Straight Rod Tube (2 total—1 each side).
- Attach (2) Bow Rod Tubes by slipping the Frame Coupler halfway onto each tube.
 - Use Frame Coupler window to make sure each Bow Rod Tube and Straight Rod Tube connect at the center of the Frame Coupler. DO NOT completely tighten.
- c. Slip (1) Frame Coupler over the front end of a **Bow Rod Tube**.
- d. Connect the (2) Bow Rod Tube ends by slipping the Frame
 Coupler halfway onto each tube.
 - Use Frame Coupler window to make sure the Bow Rod Tubes are centered in the Frame Coupler. DO NOT completely tighten.

14. Connect Molded Thigh Hook and Front Hook Supports

- Slide (2) Front Hook Supports into the Molded Thigh Hook posts on its underside.
- Attach Molded Thigh Hook to the (2) Front Hook Supports by installing and clipping the (2) Bail Pins.

15. Attach Bow Molded Thigh Hook

- Attach (2) Front Hook Supports to the front of the Bow Rod Tubes.
 - i. Assemble with (2) U-Bolts from the underside of the tube with threads running through the (2) LoPro holes.
 - ii. Place washers on threaded ends of the U-Bolts, tighten nuts onto the LoPros. **DO NOT** completely tighten.
 - iii. Center Molded Thigh Hook at the front of the frame and adjust so that the top is horizontally level. COMPLETELY tighten U-Bolt nuts.

16. Attach Anchor Tube — Right

- a. Insert Anchor Rope through the pulley end of the Anchor Tube —
 Right and run completely through the tube.
- b. Attach Anchor Tube Right to the Stern Rod Tube Combo Brackets.
 - Assemble with (2) U-Bolts from the underside of the Anchor Tube, with threads running through the Rod Tube Combo Brackets.
 - ii. Place washers on threaded ends of the U-Bolts and tighten nuts. **DO NOT** completely tighten.

17. Attach Anchor Tube — Left

- Attach Anchor Tube Left to the Stern Rod Tube Combo Brackets.
 - Assemble with (2) U-Bolts from the underside of the Anchor Tube with threads running through the Rod Tube Combo Brackets.
 - ii. Place washers on threaded ends of the U-Bolt and tighten nuts

using a ½" socket wrench. **DO NOT** completely tighten.

18. Connect Anchor Tubes

- a. Slip (1) Frame Coupler over the back end of an Anchor Tube.
- b. Connect the (2) Anchor Tube ends by slipping the Frame Coupler halfway onto each tube.
 - Use Frame Coupler window to make sure the Anchor Tubes are centered in the Frame Coupler. DO NOT completely tighten.

19. Attach Stern Rod Tubes

- a. Slip (1) Frame Coupler over the back of each Straight Rod Tube (2 total 1 each side).
- b. Attach (2) **Stern Rod Tubes** by slipping the **Frame Coupler** halfway onto the tube.
 - Use Frame Coupler window to make sure the Stern Rod Tube and Straight Rod Tube connect at the center of the Frame Coupler. DO NOT completely tighten.
- c. Slip (1) Frame Coupler over the back end of a Stern Rod Tube.
- d. Connect (2) **Stern Rod Tube** ends by slipping the **Frame Coupler** halfway onto each tube.
 - Use Frame Coupler window to make sure the Stern Rod Tubes are centered in the Frame Coupler. DO NOT completely tighten.

20. Attach Connector Plate

- a. Remove all (4) Bolts on the (2) Frame Couplers at the stern.
- b. Connect (2) Frame Couplers to the Connector Plate using all (4)
 Bolts. COMPLETELY tighten all (4) Bolts.

21. Attach Motor Mount

- a. Assemble (2) Mounting Plates over the center of the Anchor Tubes and Stern Rod Tubes.
 - Attach Mounting Plates with (2) 1-1/2" screws using a #3
 Phillips screwdriver. The screw heads should be outside of the stern frame. COMPLETELY tighten Screws.

22. Tighten Frame Couplers

a. **COMPLETELY** tighten the remaining (5) **Frame Couplers** on the raft frame with a 1/2" socket wrench.

23. Attach 32" Stern Cross Bar

- Attach 32" Stern Cross Bar by spanning across the left and right Anchor Tubes.
 - i. Assemble with (2) U-Bolts on the underside of the tube with threads running through the (2) LoPro holes.
 - ii. Place washers on threaded ends of the U-Bolts and tighten nuts onto the LoPros.

24. Connect Molded Thigh Hook and Rear Hook Supports

- a. Slide (2) Rear Hook Supports into the Molded Thigh Hook posts on its underside.
- b. Attach **Molded Thigh Hook** to the (2) **Rear Hook Supports** by installing and clipping the (2) Bail Pins.

25. Attach Stern Molded Thigh Hook

- a. Attach (2) Rear Hook Supports to the Stern Cross Bar.
 - i. Assemble with (2) U-Bolts on the underside of the tube with threads running through the (2) LoPro holes.
 - ii. Place washers on threaded ends of the U-Bolts, finger-tighten

- nuts onto the LoPros. **DO NOT** completely tighten.
- iii. Center **Molded Thigh Hook** on the **Stern Cross Bar** and adjust so that the top is level. **COMPLETELY** tighten U-Bolt nuts.

26. Attach Stern Seat Bar

- a. Attach Stern Seat Bar by spanning across the left and right Stern Rod Tubes.
 - i. Assemble with (2) U-Bolts on the underside of the tube with threads running through the (2) LoPro holes.
 - ii. Place washers on threaded ends of the U-Bolts, finger-tighten nuts onto the (2) LoPros.
- b. Place Universal Seat Mount onto center of Stern Seat Bar.
 - i. Assemble with (2) U-Bolts on the underside of the tube with threads running through the (2) LoPro holes.

27. Attach Swivel Seat

- Attach Swivel to remaining Folding Seat with bolts (taped to the underside of seat).
 - i. **COMPLETELY** tighten bolts with 3/8" socket wrench.
- Attach Swivel Seat to Universal Seat Mount with (4) 1/4" Bolts, (8)
 Washers, and (4) Nuts.
 - Place a Washer on each Bolt, feed Bolt from the top down, through the Swivel and down through the Universal Seat Mount. Add another Washer and Nut on the underside to secure the bolt. DO NOT completely tighten.
 - ii. Repeat above process on remaining 3 corners.
 - iii. Tip: Use a 7/16" open-end wrench to hold the Bolt head. Tighten Nut with 7/16" socket wrench.

28. Attach Straps — Side Tubes

Use (4) **3' NRS Straps** to secure the Approach frame to the raft through the (4) side D-rings.

- Feed the end of the NRS Strap underneath the Slot Rail, around the Bracket, and back through the D-ring on the side of the raft tube.
- b. Run the strap end through the locking cam of the strap. Pull strap to tighten.
 - Repeat steps a. and b. until the frame is secured through all four D-rings.
- c. Firmly pull down on each **NRS Strap** to secure the frame to the raft. The frame should be centered on top of the tubes.

29. Attach Straps — Front Frame

Use (1) **4' NRS Strap** to secure the Approach frame to the raft through the front D-ring.

- a. Feed the end of the NRS Strap underneath the Slot Rail on one side of the Frame Coupler, down through the D-ring on the bow raft tube, and back underneath the Slot Rail on the other side of the Frame Coupler.
- Run the strap end through the locking cam of the strap. Pull strap to tighten.
- c. Firmly pull down on the NRS Strap to secure the frame to the raft.

30. Attach Straps — Back Frame

Use (1) **4' NRS Strap** to secure the Approach frame to the raft through the back D-ring.

- a. Feed the end of the NRS Strap over an Anchor Tube on one side of the stern, down through the D-ring on the stern raft tube, and back over the other Anchor Tube.
- b. Run the strap end through the locking cam of the strap. Pull strap to tighten.
- c. Firmly pull down on the NRS Strap to secure the frame to the raft.

31. Install Anchor Rope

- Secure the tail end of the 3/8" Anchor Rope to the eyebolt on the frame's stern using a bowline knot.
- Attach Anchor Rope Guide to the stern D-ring and run Anchor Rope through the Anchor Rope Guide ring.
- Thread the Anchor Rope from the Anchor Tube Right, inside
 the raft, under the Rower's Dry Box, through the SpinLock
 Anchor Cam Lock and around the Intermediate Pulley.
- d. Pull the free end of the **Anchor Rope**, passing rope through pulley until the remaining rope is inside on the floor of the raft.

32. Attach Rod Tube Loops

- a. Run the bungee loop down through one of the holes on the Straight Rod Tube, back up through the other hole on the Straight Rod Tube, and back through the middle of the two bungee cords at the pull tab.
- b. Pull on the **Bungee Rope** tab to secure the **Rod Tube Loop**.
- c. Repeat for all four Rod Tube Loops.

33. Attach Rod Tube Trim

- Attach Rod Tube Trim around the curved edges at both end of the Straight Rod Tube slots.
- b. Secure the trim by firmly pressing into place.
- 34. Check that all bolts are fully tightened.
- 35. Fully inflate raft (2 PSI) before use.
